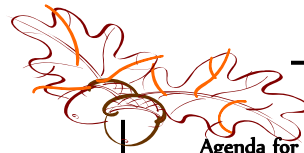

### SCRIP

In the next week or so, information regarding the Nova Scrip Program will go out detailing the Scrip ordering procedure and the participating retailers. Scrip is a great opportunity to purchase merchandize cards (no different from what you get directly from the source) for the retailers you use anyway-Cub foods, gas stations, clothing stores and hundreds more, and at the same time generate money (up to 13%) from each sale for Nova and the PTO.

(Proceeds generated by the NPTO in excess of its annual budget will be donated directly to Nova's general fund.)

### Other Fund Raisers

**Box Tops:** the fall deadline is next week. Please bring in your trimmed box tops to the collection box in the upper hall.

**Target Card:** don't forget to designate Nova on your Target Card. It takes minutes and gives Nova 1% back on Target purchases and 5% on purchases made elsewhere.

**School POP:** use this online server to shop and the NPTO will receive a percentage of the sale. You must designate Nova as your school. I.D. # is 119473
