Because participating in the current theater production is a privilege, there are a few guidelines that must be followed by all the actors involved.

RESPECT:

You, as friends and actors, are expected to respect your fellow thespians and treat everyone as equal. The director, stage manager, music director, choreographer, producer, and any guest teachers will be treated with the same courteous behavior.

FOCUS:

All students must come to rehearsal ready to work and focus and learn. In order for the play to come together, we must all work as one unit that is ready to concentrate our energy to our performance.

LISTENING:

When we have discussions or small group meetings, we need to all give respect to the speaker. There will be a warning given and if poor behavior continues, the student will be asked to sit away from the group.

PARTICIPATION:

It is imperative that each student comes to rehearsal each day with an open mind. We will be doing many warm-ups and acting exercises that may seem silly at times. If every student does the exercise, it will improve your performance. This is meant to be a community where you can loosen up and let go of your "attitude" or your school persona. We are all equal in the cast.

ATTENDANCE:

Unless notified before the auditions, each member of the cast is expected to attend EVERY REHEARSAL THEY ARE SCHEDULED FOR. Please make sure that your conflicts are correct before agreeing to a role. Missed rehearsals can waste not only the director's time, but your fellow actor's time as well.

Any student that disobeys or disrespects any of these rules has the potential to be asked to leave the cast and give up their part.
