 - -Complete the FAFSA as soon as possible after it opens
 - -Use separate email addresses when you and your parents/guardians create FSA IDs
 - -Collect FAFSA and financial aid material from me, from your Google Classroom, or on the "College Prep" web-page of the Nova website (within the "<u>School</u> <u>Counseling</u>" tab)
 - -Financial aid night will occur the first week of October
- *Discover if you will need to complete the <u>CSS Profile</u> for any of your schools; you may need to complete the CSS Profile by your early action admission deadlines or in mid-January for regular decision deadlines
